Project update

Roads and Maritime Service will be starting the next stage of major work on the intersection shortly.

This is a substantial road project that requires traffic changes to be in place to complete the work safely. The project will improve road safety and traffic efficiency at this intersection.

A traffic management plan for this stage of the work was implemented on Monday 8 October. This plan was unsuccessful and we would like to apologise for the unacceptable traffic delays experienced by road users. Immediate action was taken to improve the traffic flow during peak times. This included:

- Reinstatement of the existing roundabout during peak times
- A full review of the traffic management plan
- Close monitoring of traffic conditions.



Revised traffic management plan



We have carried out a full review of the traffic management plan for the project.

A number of options were considered and analysed using both existing and new traffic data. Our preferred option delivers the best outcomes for road users and will provide a more effective traffic flow during morning and afternoon peak times.

This will be implemented by early November and includes:

- Installation of a smaller roundabout at the intersection
- Provision of a dual right turn into Lanyon Drive
- A continuous left slip lane for vehicles turning left from Jerrabomberra
- All other movements through the intersection will be enabled during peak times without diversions in place.

Traffic changes outside of peak time (between 9:30am and 3:30pm) may include intermittent temporary lane closures so essential work can be completed.

To minimise disruption some construction work will be required to be completed at night. Night work will be carried out periodically between 7pm and 5am, traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction and stop slow traffic control will be in operation.

The community will be kept informed of any changes as the project progresses.

Stakeholder engagement

We are engaging directly with key stakeholders, including emergency services to discuss contingency plans for vehicles travelling through the intersection to ensure our work does not impact any critical services.
